Akron Association Of Ohio University Women's Lillie Greer Scholarship Fund	This scholarship for students in the Honors tutorial College who demonstrate financial need. It is intended for a resident of Summit County; if no qualified applicant from Summit County exists, a qualified applicant may be selected from residents of Stark, Medina, Portage or Wayne counties. Default GPA of 3.4 is required. Established in 1997 in honor of Lillie Greer, one of the founders of the Akron Women. Endowed in 2004.
The Ohio University Women's Club Of Cleveland Freshman Scholarship Fund	For full-time incoming freshman women from the greater Cleveland area of Ohio. Applicants must have earned at least a 25 ACT and/or 1140 SAT and have a minimum 3.5 cumulative g.p.a. on a scale of 4.0 for six semesters and rank in the upper 20% of their senior high school class. Established in 1986.
Ruth Fowler Brown Upper-class Endowed Scholarship Fund	Restricted to female upper-class students from the Cleveland area. Recommendations made by the club, with election based on academic excellence. Established in honor of the founder and past president of the Ohio University Women's Club of Greater Cleveland.
Central Ohio Chapter Ohio University Alumni Association Endowed Scholarship	Recipient should be full-time undergraduate student at the Athens campus. The recipient should have a 3.0 cumulative g.p.a., be a resident of Franklin, Madison, Delaware or Union counties and be the son or daughter of an Ohio University alumnus. Established in 1998.
OU Cleveland Parents Chapter Scholarship	Recipients must be upperclassmen (defined as having earned a minimum of 45 hours) who are residents of the greater Cleveland area (defined as Cuyahoga, Lorain, Lake, Medina, Geauga, Summit and Portage Counties). Recipients must be dependents of members of the Ohio University Cleveland Parents Club and have an accumulative GPA of at least 3.0. Established in 2001.
Joseph M. Lichtenberg Memorial Scholarship (Nation's Capital)	For full-time juniors or seniors majoring in journalism within the College of Communication. Applicants must have a minimum g.p.a. of 3.0 within their major. Selection made by the School of Journalism Scholarship Committee. Established in 1992.
Carolinas Scholarship Fund	This scholarship is intended for a resident of either North Carolina or South Carolina. Established in 2003.
Fairfield County Ohio University Alumni Scholarship Fund	Recipients(s) must be residents of Fairfield County unless they are children or grandchildren of members of the Fairfield County Chapter Ohio University Alumni Association. Recipients may hold any class rank including incoming freshmen. The value of the scholarship will not exceed the cost of tuition and/or estimated cost of books. This is a renewable scholarship. The minimum amount awarded is \$500.
Greater Cincinnati Alumni Chapter Scholarship	Recipient must be from the Greater Cincinnati area and have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and demonstrate financial need. Established in 1995 - new guidelines in 2001.
Dayton Chapter OU Alumni Association Scholarship Fund	Recipient must be a full-time undergraduate student from the Greater Dayton Area. Established in 1978.
School of Music Society Scholarship Fund	Full time undergraduate majoring in an academic area of the School of Music that has financial need and at least a 3.0 GPA. Established 1987.
Army ROTC Endowment Fund	Funds to be used at the discretion of the Professor of Military Science to support the Army ROTC program and scholarships for active members. Established 2002.

Ice Hockey Endowment Fund (AKA Blue Line Boosters Hockey Society)	To provide support to Ice Hockey at OU. Established in 1983.
Kala Singh Professional Development Fund (AKA Hearing Speech and Languages Society)	Supports professional development in the School of Hearing, Speech, and Language Sciences - provides resources for research, travel, and equipment. Overseen by the director of the School and student driven needs are to be considered first. Established in 2002.
The Effie and Kent Chapman Endowment Fund	Annual earnings shall be used for: 75% as a scholarship to an undergraduate student (including freshman) that is a resident of Cleveland (or suburbs). 25% shall be donated to the Ohio University Women's Club of Cleveland Alumni Association Endowment. Established in 1984.
Black Alumni Reunion Urban Scholars Fund (formerly National Black Alumni Scholarship Fund)	For sophomores, juniors or seniors that are black Americans. Based on financial need, academic merit (at least 3.0) and leadership qualities demonstrated in participation in campus activities and organizations. Established 1988.
The W Barry Adams Scholarship Fund	For freshmen graduating from Circleville (Ohio) High School with at least a 2.75 GPA. Participation in student activities and financial need shall be considered. Established 1989.
The George and Ruth Brown Scholarship Fund for Athletics	For full time students that participate in Intercollegiate Athletics. Financial need and academic merit not to be considered prime factors in selection. Established 1981. Supported by the Cleveland Women.
Student Alumni Board Scholarship Fund	Full time juniors with a GPA of at least 3.3 . Achievement and merit to be considered as well as time, talent, and energy in positive campus activities.
The Senior Class of 1983 Scholarship Fund	Full time student on Athens Campus. Established in 1983 and updated 2007.
Judith M Johnson Recognition Award	For Students working for University Advancement. Established in 2007. Not yet awarded - has not met minimum endowment level.
The Golden Alumni Society Scholarship Fund	Full-time undergraduate student on the Athens campus with at least a 3.0
The Ohio University License Plate Scholarship	Proceeds from the Ohio University License plater are required to go to a scholarship. Awarded to a full-time undergrad at the Athens Campus that is a permanent resident of the State of Ohio. If the funds reach the level to become a Cutler Scholarship (\$200,000), these guidelines may be modified to make this into a full tuition scholarship. Established in 1994, before that the money went into the general scholarship fund.
Ohio University Alumni Association Legacy Scholarship	Current undergraduate student at Ohio University with a parent, grandparent, or legal guardian who is graduate of Ohio University and has at least a 3.0 GPA
Scripps Society Of Alumni & Friends Internship Support Fund	Supports students in the Journalism School who are pursuing internships.
