**Day 1: Thursday, April 22, 2010  
Scottsdale, Arizona - Tour Begins**

**Day 3: Saturday, April 24, 2010  
Scottsdale - Sedona - Grand Canyon**

★**Begin the day with a visit to the beautiful city of Sedona and take some time to shop in the marketplace.**★ You will be amazed with Oak Creek Canyon, where the rock formations seem to change

hue with every turn in the road. Later, as you travel through the spectacular Kaibab National Forest, you will reach the South Rim of the Grand Canyon. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

**Day 4: Sunday, April 25, 2010  
Grand Canyon - Lake Powell**

This morning you will have ample time to explore the Grand Canyon. Behold amazing views of the canyon with a drive along the South Rim. Theodore Roosevelt, upon visiting the canyon, is quoted as saying, "This is one of the great sights which every American, if he can travel at all, must see." Later, a short drive brings you to Cameron Trading Post. For nearly a century, the post has been a haven for travelers, traders, and explorers who come from all points of the globe to see the wonder of the Grand Canyon and experience the Native American cultures of the Southwest. Continue north through mesa-studded desert scenery before arriving at your home for the next two evenings, Lake Powell Resort, a stunning hotel that overlooks the sparkling blue waters of Lake Powell. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

**Day 5: Monday, April 26, 2010  
Lake Powell - Monument Valley - Lake Powell**

★**Begin your day with an invigorating breakfast cruise\*\* along lovely Lake Powell.**★ Journey through the territory of

the Navajo nation and arrive in Monument Valley, a sacred Navajo land featuring colorful sandstone spires that rise hundreds of feet from the valley floor. Enjoy an exciting Jeep tour, narrated by one of the Navajo tribe members. A stop will be made at a Hogan. The history and symbolism of a Hogan represents every aspect of Navajo life: their thinking, reasoning, planning and their philosophy. Later today, return to Lake Powell for an evening of leisure.

**Day 6: Tuesday, April 27, 2010  
Lake Powell - Bryce Canyon National Park - Zion Canyon National Park**

★**Today, travel to Bryce Canyon National Park, truly one of the most spectacular scenic wonders of the world.**★ The formations within Bryce Canyon National Park, called Hoodoos, are the creation of wind and water erosion over eons of time. Iron oxidizing within the rock causes the natural orange and red hues that color these formations. Your final destination for the day is the red and white sandstone cliffs of Zion Canyon National Park\*\*\*. In sheer magnitude and color, Zion is very likely one of the most awe-inspiring national parks in the world. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

**Day 7: Wednesday, April 28, 2010**  
**Zion Canyon National Park - Las Vegas, Nevada**

Leave nature's beauty behind for the glitz and glamour of the Las Vegas strip. Probably the most famous stretch of road in the world, its 4 miles of neon-lit resorts with around-the-clock action is like nowhere else on earth. A two-night stay provides you plenty of time to enjoy the shows, the casinos and all the fun. *Today breakfast will be included.*

**Day 8: Thursday, April 29, 2010**  
**Las Vegas**

Truly an experience of a lifetime!!! This is your opportunity to enjoy a picnic lunch by the banks of the Colorado River within the Grand Canyon-spectacular!!! During this excursion you are afforded a bird's eye view of historic Lake Mead, Boulder City, Hoover Dam and extinct volcanoes on a narrated helicopter flight over the secluded Grand Canyon's West Rim. During your flight, you will descend 4,000 feet to the canyon floor to observe over two billion years of history along the canyon walls with its carved layers and dramatic rock formations. You'll arrive next to the banks of the Colorado River to enjoy a picnic meal, served under an authentic Indian Ramada. This optional tour offers you the opportunity to take great photos as well as enjoy time for exploration on the Hualapai native lands. Please note: An estimated \$10-\$30 fuel surcharge fee is NOT included in the cost of this option and is subject to the discretion of the supplier. ### Indian Adventure & Skywalk

This excursion truly gives you unique insight into the lives of the Plains Indians. Your flight from Las Vegas includes majestic views of Lake Mead, the Hoover Dam and the West Rim of the Grand Canyon. Upon arrival in the valley of the Hualapai, transfer up via the area shuttle to the Hualapai Nation. The village consists of five smaller villages depicting different tribes from the nearby regions. Here you will have time to learn about unique artifacts such as the Sweat lodge of the Havasupai Tribe, the tipi from the Plains tribe, the Hogan of the Navajo tribe, the wiki up of the Hualapai tribe and the houses of the Hopi tribe. In the center of all the villages are amphitheaters, which house daily Native American presentations and performances. There will be an opportunity to walk along the seventy foot glass viewing bridge perched 4,000 feet above the Grand Canyon floor, at an additional cost, should you choose. There are no words to describe the spectacular views and the feeling of walking with only a piece of glass between you and the canyon floor below. Ground time on the canyon's West Rim is approximately 3 hours. A light meal is included with the tour at Guano Point.
