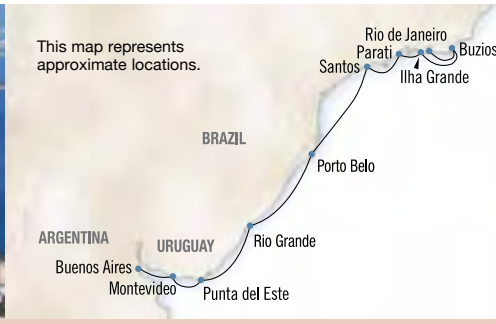

# Ports of Call

## BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA
